COE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIPS

The new Coe Memorial Scholarship Program awards four \$1,000 grants to four graduating high school seniors. The students can be from Cody or Meeteetse. They need to enroll in a college of their choice as a full-time student. Only students that major in pre-med with plans to become a physician will qualify for the grants. They will qualify for additional \$1,000 grants their sophomore, junior, and senior years of study but have to re-apply each year.

If accepted in an approved physician degree graduate school program, the committee will choose one student (from the original four students) to receive a \$5,000 grant each year for three years. They will have to re-apply each year. Once they graduate from medical school, they will receive a \$1,000 bonus.

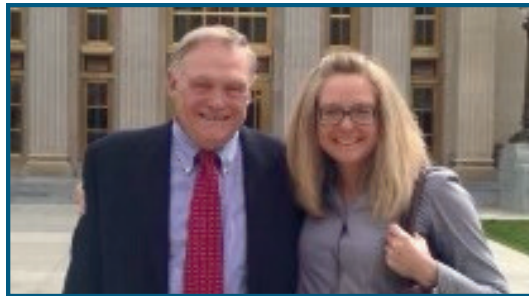
Medical students often spend more than a decade preparing for the profession between college, medical school, residency, and specialization. They also must pay for room and board. A report from the Association of American Medical Colleges (AAMC) found the median four-year cost at U.S. Medical School exceeds \$268,000.00.

CMF SCHOLARSHIP GRANTS

The CMF Scholarship Grants of \$1,000 are still available. To qualify, students need to have completed one year of college as a full-time student. Their parents must reside in the West Park Hospital District which includes the towns of Cody and Meeteetse. Applications for continued funding need to be received by August 10th.

All applicants need to major in a medically related field; for example pre-med, nursing, psychology, optometry, dentistry, and pharmacy.
