A GOOD EDUCATION - THE FOUNDATION FOR A GOOD LIFE



H.R. Coe began building the foundation for his career with his own company, Coe Construction. He earned an engineering degree from Montana State University at a time when higher education was still reasonably affordable.

Community service runs deep in the Coe family's history. H.R. Coe's great-grandfather helped construct both the W.R. Memorial Hospital and the Coe Medical Building. His grandparents, Henry and Peg Coe, each served as chairs of the Cody Medical Foundation, and his father, Hank Coe, also held that role before H.R. took over. For four generations, the Coe family has worked alongside community members to strengthen medical services throughout the West Park Hospital District.

Today, Cody Regional Health serves the entire Big Horn Basin and is recognized as one of the finest hospitals of its size in the United States.

One of the major changes in healthcare over the years has been the rising cost of education. Many medical students now graduate with more than a quarter of a million dollars in debt. Although the foundation's scholarships may seem modest, recipients often tell us the support makes a tremendous difference.

The Board of Trustees and officers extend heartfelt thanks to all who help continue this legacy of giving and community care.

COE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIPS

The new Coe Memorial Scholarship Program awards 4, \$1,000 grants to 4 graduating high school seniors from Cody or Meeteetse.

They need to enroll in a college of their choice as a full-time student. Only students that major in pre-med with plans to become a physician will qualify for the grants. They will qualify for additional \$1,000 grants their sophomore, junior, and senior years of study but have to re-apply each year.

If accepted in an approved physician degree graduate school program, the committee will choose one student (from the original 4) to receive a \$5,000 grant each year for three years. They will have to re-apply each year.

Once they graduate from medical school, they receive a \$1,000 bonus. Medical students often spend more than a decade preparing for the profession between college, medical school, residency, and specialization. They also must pay for room and board. A report from the Association of American Medical Colleges (AAMC) found the median four-year cost at U.S. Medical School exceeds \$268,000.00.

SCHOLARSHIPS

The Cody Medical Foundation awards several types of scholarships each year to high school and college students who are pursuing a medical related career.

The annual scholarships for \$1000.00, known as the **Cody Medical Foundation Scholarship Grants** are still available. To qualify, students need to have completed one year of college as a full-time student. Their parents must reside in the West Park Hospital District, which includes the towns of Cody and Meeteetse. Applications for continued funding need to be received by August 10th. Applications are available online at www.codymedicalfoundation.org.

Applicants need to major in a medically related field; for example pre-med, nursing, psychology, optometry, dentistry, and pharmacy.
